

## CABIN BREEZE - NEW VENTILATION SAIL

Waterline Design's smart mosquito nets and blinds are known for simple and quick installation: A strong foldable steel ring is holding the blinds and mosquito nets under a deck hatch and they are held in place by a center upward force. The same design has now also been used for the new Cabin Breeze ventilation sail that catches large amount of air and leads it under deck. The foldable steel ring is slightly larger than the opening and fits snugly from the inside. Installation is thus even possible for flush-mounted hatches. No other fittings such as strings are necessary at the bottom. A special feature is the baton that spreads out the edges of the sail, keeping its intended shape even during the lightest of winds.

The Cabin Breeze allows for good ventilation and cooling under deck even at very low wind speeds. At the same time, the sturdy design remains in place even when the wind picks up.

Initially available in two sizes to fit most types of deck hatches: 500 x 500 and 600 x 600mm.

Installation could not be easier and is done within seconds: the Cabin Breeze is placed into a hatch by simply unfolding its steel ring. Once put in place under the hatch, its top is

hoisted by means of a halyard, a topping lift or just a dedicated line. For center cockpit boats, it fits perfectly over the aft cabin hatch and is here easily kept in place by attaching its top to the end of the boom.
